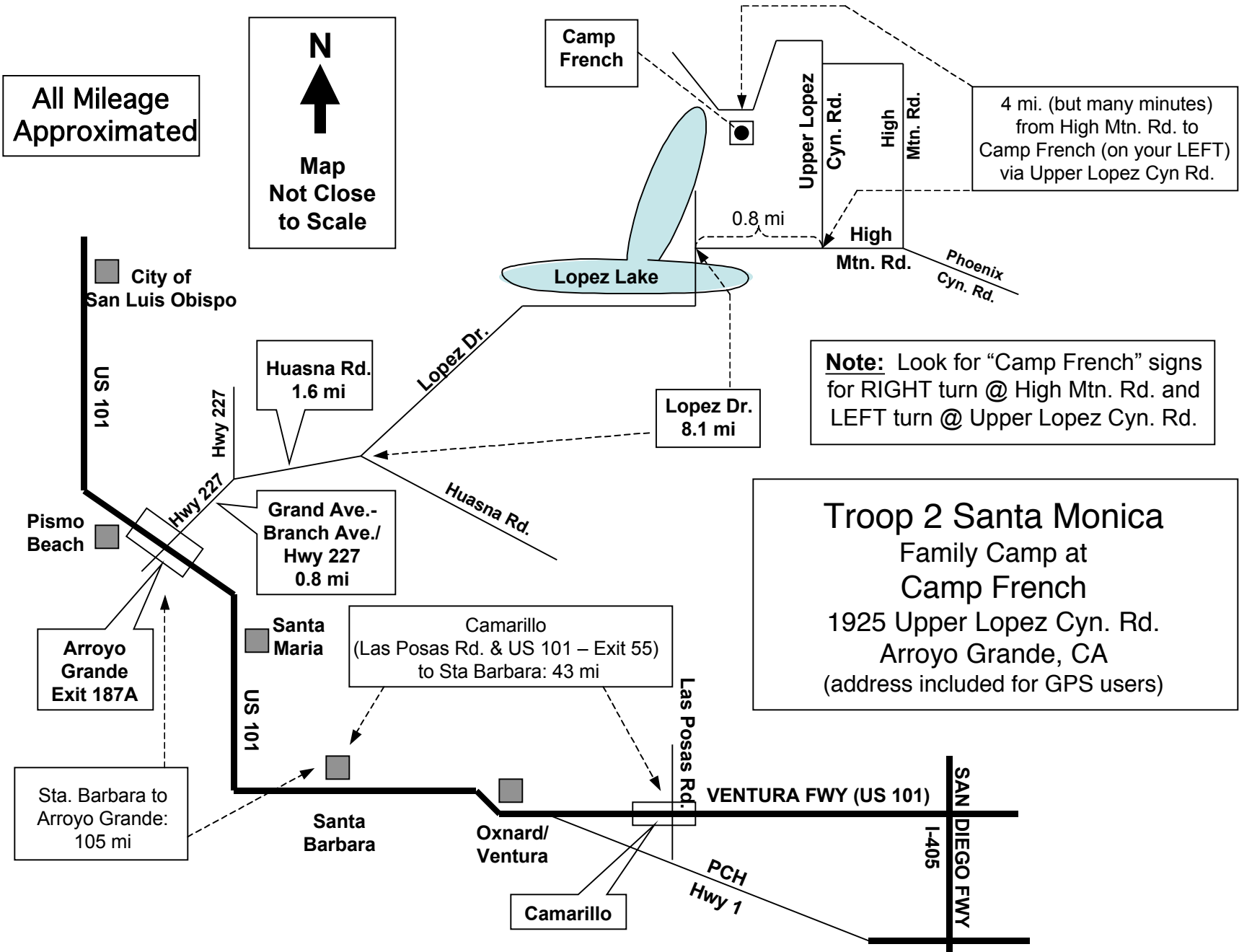


All Mileage

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP MABEL FRENCH FAMILY CAMP:

From Santa Monica taking PCH:

- Take **PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY/Hwy 1** north past the big rock at Point Mugu to the first offramp (what's an offramp doing here?) at **LAS POSAS RD. in Port Hueneme** (approx. **35 miles** from the California Incline and PCH).
- Go north on Las Posas Rd. approx. **12 miles** to the **US 101 north towards Ventura**. As you get to US 101 **HEADS UP: stay RIGHT and cloverleaf onto the freeway**.
- See "From Las Posas Rd. and US 101" below.

From I-405 and US 101:

- From the intersection of I-405 (San Diego Fwy) and US 101 (Ventura Fwy) take the **VENTURA FWY (US 101) towards Ventura**.
- Go approx. **39 miles** to **LAS POSAS RD. (Exit 55)**.
- See "From Las Posas Rd. and US 101" below.

From Las Posas Rd. and US 101:

- Continue north on US 101 through the city of Santa Barbara, past where US 101 turns north, goes through the Gaviota Tunnel (yes, that's the tunnel in the *The Graduate*), the city of Santa Maria, into San Luis Obispo county, to **HWY 227 North/GRAND AVE. (Exit 187-A)**. (**Note:** Las Posas Rd. to Hwy 227 North/Grand Ave. exit: approx. **148 miles**).
- At the end of the offramp turn **RIGHT** onto Grand Ave. At your first stop light, Grand Ave. becomes **BRANCH AVE.** (don't pay no mind; just a street name change). Continue along Branch Ave. Approx. **0.8 miles from the freeway** offramp the road angles to the right and becomes **HUASNA RD.** (again, just a name change; nothing else).
- Approx. **2.4 miles from the freeway**, Huasna Rd. becomes **LOPEZ DR.** (there will be a test).
- At approx. **8 miles from the freeway** you will start to see water (that's Lopez Lake – nice, huh?). Continue on Lopez Dr. to approx. **10.6 miles from the freeway** to the "Camp French (RIGHT arrow)" sign at **HIGH MOUNTAIN RD.**
- Turn **RIGHT** on High Mountain Rd. Go approx. **0.8 miles** to the "Camp French (LEFT arrow)" sign at **UPPER LOPEZ CANYON RD.**
- Turn **LEFT** on Upper Lopez Canyon. By the map, you're really close, but by the road, take your time, because it's steep and winding, and will take you about longer than you think to get to the camp from here. Just stay on Upper Lopez Canyon Rd. for approx. **4 miles** to
