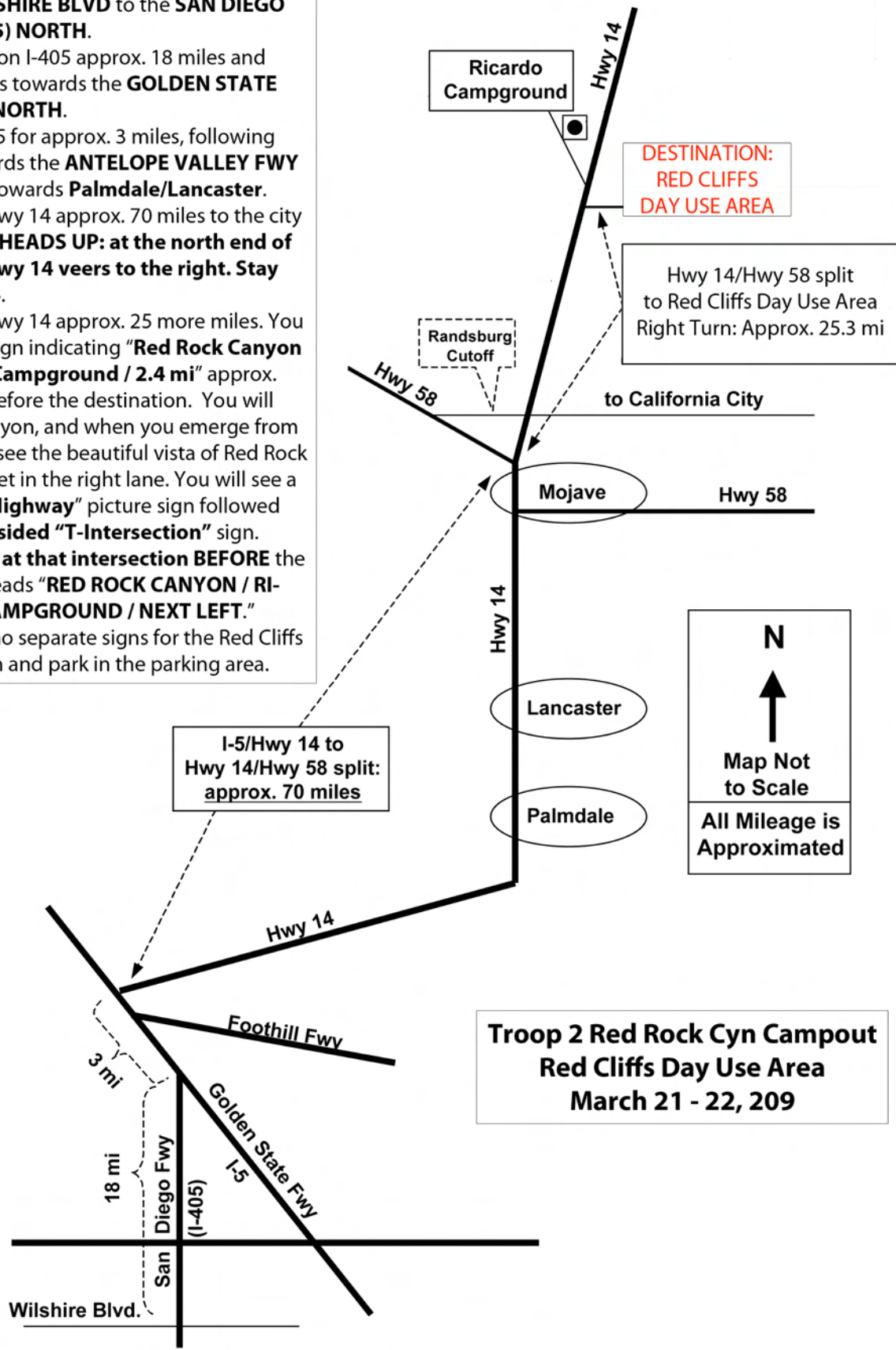


From Lincoln Middle School:

- Take **WILSHIRE BLVD** to the **SAN DIEGO FWY (I-405) NORTH**.
- Go north on I-405 approx. 18 miles and follow signs towards the **GOLDEN STATE FWY (I-5) NORTH**.
- Stay on I-5 for approx. 3 miles, following signs towards the **ANTELOPE VALLEY FWY (Hwy 14) towards Palmdale/Lancaster**.
- Stay on Hwy 14 approx. 70 miles to the city of Mojave. **HEADS UP: at the north end of Mojave, Hwy 14 veers to the right. Stay on Hwy 14.**
- Stay on Hwy 14 approx. 25 more miles. You will see a sign indicating "**Red Rock Canyon / Ricardo Campground / 2.4 mi**" approx. 2.2 miles before the destination. You will enter a canyon, and when you emerge from it, you will see the beautiful vista of Red Rock Canyon. Get in the right lane. You will see a "**Divided Highway**" picture sign followed by a **right-sided "T-Intersection"** sign. **Turn right at that intersection BEFORE** the sign that reads "**RED ROCK CANYON / RICARDO CAMPGROUND / NEXT LEFT.**" There are no separate signs for the Red Cliffs area. Pull in and park in the parking area.
